

Terms of Use

Basic Animal Control Officer Training Program

Pursuant to Kentucky law, Animal Control Officers employed in the Commonwealth of Kentucky must complete the Kentucky Animal Care & Control Association's ("KACCA") Basic Animal Control Officer online training program (the "Program"), which was established by the Kentucky Animal Control Advisory Board ("Board"). The Board, which seeks to set high standards for facilities that care for homeless companion animals in the Commonwealth, established the Program which is designed around the Kentucky Animal Control Officer Training manual created by KACCA and approved by the Board.

KACCA's membership is made up of Animal Control Officers and Animal Shelter teams in the Commonwealth of Kentucky charged with the statutory responsibility of providing animal services to our respective jurisdictions for the sake of public health and safety. For purposes of these Terms of Use, the Board and KACCA are referred to as "us" and "we."
